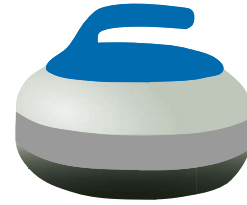

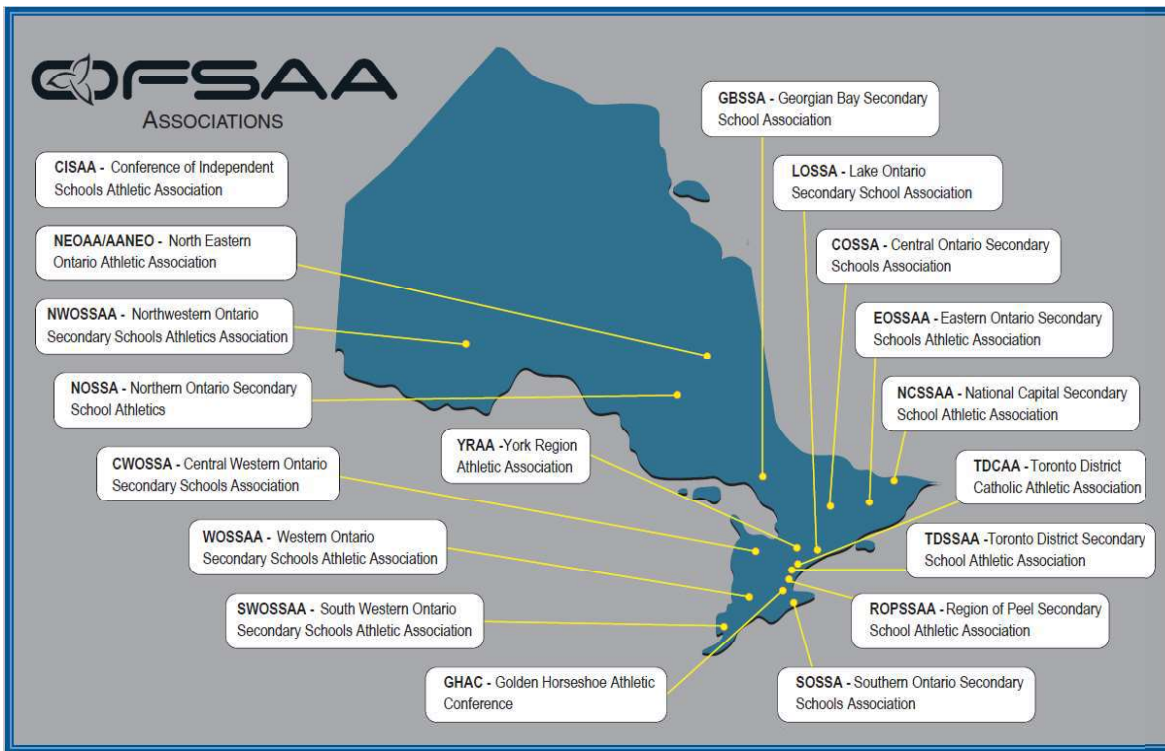

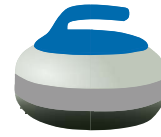

Trevor Bonot has been curling in Thunder Bay for over 20 years and is a well-known part of the local curling community.

Over that time, he has played out of the Fort William, Port Arthur, and Stratton Curling Clubs, earning a reputation as a steady, reliable competitor and respected teammate.

Trevor is recognized for his sportsmanship and his experience competing at the highest levels of the sport. As a skip, he has represented Northern Ontario on the national stage, including an appearance at the 2024 Montana's Brier.

In addition to being a NOCA provincial champion, Trevor has enjoyed significant national success. He captured gold at the 2017 Canadian Mixed Championship and returned to the podium in 2022, earning a silver medal. Internationally, Trevor represented Team Canada at the World Mixed Curling Championship, where he earned a silver medal. Competing on the world stage provided him with valuable insight into performing under pressure, teamwork, and elite-level preparation. In recognition of these achievements, Trevor and his team were inducted into the Northwestern Ontario Sports Hall of Fame in 2022.

Passionate about giving back to the sport, Trevor is committed to mentoring the next generation of curlers, sharing lessons on goal setting, resilience, leadership, and balancing athletics with academics.
