Motions must be written on the form provided (available on the web site or from the office), and submitted to the Executive Director by October 1st for the fall representatives' council meeting, and February 15th for the Annual Assembly. Motions not received by these deadlines will be dealt with at a subsequent meeting, unless they are urgent in nature, in which case, the Council members may elect to waive the notification period. All motions shall be moved and seconded by either a teacher, (current/retired) school administrator, or a member of the OFSAA Executive Council.
